(Focus: Food Lexicon and Plural Nouns)

This interactive song focuses on food vocabulary and the inductive acquisition of plural nouns. By dragging multiple items (tomatoes, mushrooms) onto the pizza, children physically experience the concept of "more than one" without a single line of explanatory text.

[Intro] 


"Are you hungry?  Let's make a pizza! 


One, two, three... GO!"
