(Focus: Morning Routine and Action Verbs)


Based on the Total Physical Response (TPR) method, this song simulates "language-body conversations" where the child reacts to instructions before being expected to produce speech. This "silent period" approach allows children to absorb sound patterns and verb meanings through direct physical imitation.
